

ITINERARY:

A detailed guide for visiting Wayand

Wayanad is a rural district in Kerala state, southwest India. In the east, the Wayanad Wildlife Sanctuary is a lush, forested region with areas of high altitude, home to animals including Asiatic elephants, tigers, leopards and egrets. In the Ambukuthi Hills to the south, Edakkal Caves contain ancient petroglyphs, some dating back to the Neolithic age.

DAY 1 - Wayanad

In north-eastern Kerala, lying in the lap of Western Ghats is the delightful town of Wayanad, acclaimed for being a home for those that love nature. Dabbed with a few slopes and rich timberlands, here you can discover wilderness trails, treks, pleasant cascades and waterways.

On your landing in Calicut Airport/Rail way station meet our delegate and drive to Wayanad (80 Kms) the new age tourist destination of Kerala. Here, you will get the chance to take advantage of the heap of attractions and in addition spend time involving yourself in the lap of Mother Nature for each voyager. Once you arrive at Wayanad, check in to the pre-booked hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 2 - In & Around Wayanad

After breakfast leave for Soochipara waterfalls, It is a three-step waterfall of more than 200 ms in height with a fantastic scenery. Here you can enjoy water-rafting, swimming, and bathing in the pool below. This spectacular waterfall at Soochipara near Meppadi is really a treasure of nature. Leave to Edakkal caves have lunch from Ambalavayal. Edakkal caves are pre-historic caves lies 12km from SulthanBathery Two caves are located at a height of 1000 m on Ambukutty Mala near Ambalavayal. The New Stone Age pictorical writings on the walls of these natural caves at Edakkal are evidence of the civilisation that existed in these regions in prehistorical times. Back to Hotel/Resort/Homestay.

DAY 3 - Wayanad Sightseeing

Morning after breakfast time for full day sightseeing of Wayanad visiting the Banasura Sagar Dam - the largest earth dam in India and the second largest of its kind in Asia, Pazhassi Raja Tomb and Pazhassi Raja museum Mananthavady and Kuruvadweep - a series of islands formed on the Kabini river (09.30 AM to 03.30 PM... No Entry on Monsoon season & some particular Days, when animals riding in the place). Overnight stay hotel / resort at wayanad.

DAY 4 - Departure

After breakfast, the next morning we check out of the resort and proceed towards Calicut in time for your flight/train. If you have the luxury of time you can visit the Wayanad heritage museum at Ambalavayal, Jain temple at Sultan Bathery and the Phantom Rock.
