
# **SCENIC MANALI**







# **ITINERARY**:

# A detailed guide for visiting Manali

Manali is a high-altitude Himalayan resort town in India's northern Himachal Pradesh state. It has a reputation as a backpacking center and honeymoon destination. Set on the Beas River, it's a gateway for skiing in the Solang Valley and trekking in Parvati Valley. It's also a jumping-off point for paragliding, rafting and mountaineering in the Pir Panjal mountains, home to 4,000m-high Rohtang Pass.

#### Day 1 - Arrival in Manali

Manali off-ers super views of the Dhauladhar and Pir Panjal ranges, and with mountain adventures beckoning from all directions, Manali is a year-round magnet for tourists. Apart from temples, Manali is popular among adventure tourists coming for trekking, paragliding, rafting and skiing. An adventurous couple can get their fair share of adrenaline and thrill along with some romance set against an idyllic backdrop. Check-in at the hotel and spend your evening at leisure. Have a romantic dinner and stay overnight in Manali.

## Day 2 - Full Day Excursion Rohtang Pass

Start with a full day excursion to Rohtang Pass. Manali is the gateway to Rohtang pass beyond which lies the twin valley of Lahaul and Spiti. In winter the mountain slopes are snow clad and turn into perfect skiing slopes. The Rohtang pass is 51 KM north of Manali and is located on the Manali Keylong Highway at an altitude of 4111 meters (13,400 ft). The pass is open from June to October each year although trekkers can cross it earlier. It is a gateway to Lahaul Spiti, Pangi and Leh valley. The area cov-ers spectacular sights of glaciers and peaks, and the Chandra river that ows down the Lahaul valley. Also to be sighted are the twin peaks of the Geypan. Return to Manali in the evening and stay overnight at the hotel.

#### Day 3 - Sightseeing in Manali

In the morning after breakfast, go on an adventurous drive to Solang valley, a major attraction, without which the trip remains incomplete. All the above mentioned adventure activities can be availed of here at Solang Valley. Apart from activities, there are splendid views to enjoy in and around the Solang Valley. Later, during the day visit the popular Hadimba Temple, Naggar Castle and Art gallery. In the evening, go for a romantic walk along Mall Road and enjoy your dinner and overnight stay in Manali.

## Day 4 - Depart Manali

After breakfast, proceed for your onward destination.
