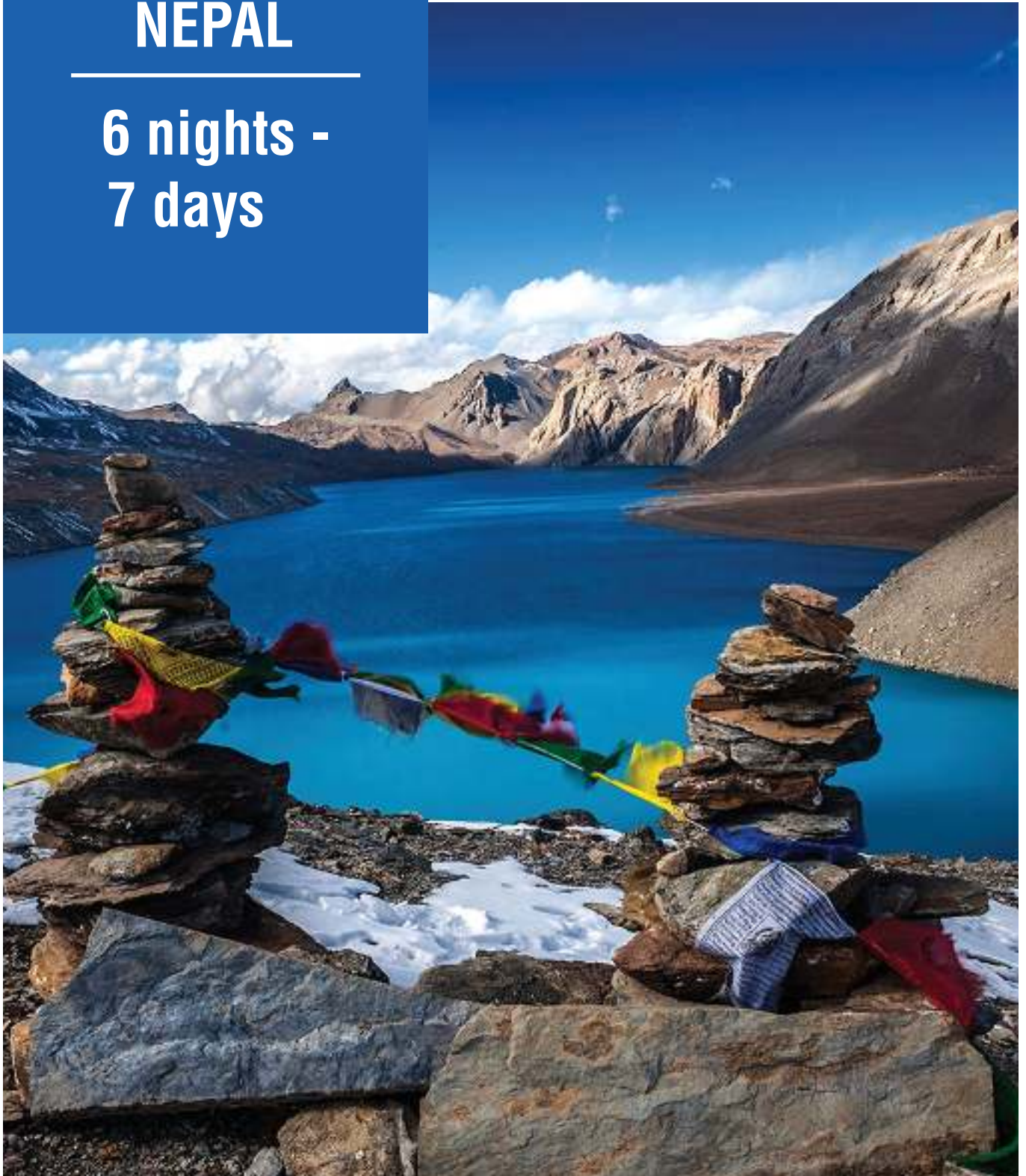

NEPAL travel guide

Explore Nepal holidays and discover the best time and places to visit. A trekkers' paradise, Nepal combines Himalayan views, golden temples, charming hill villages and jungle wildlife watching to offer one of the world's great travel destinations. Other travellers prefer to see Nepal at a more refined pace, admiring the peaks over a sunset gin and tonic from a Himalayan viewpoint, strolling through the medieval city squares of Kathmandu, Patan and Bhaktapur, and joining Tibetan Buddhist pilgrims on a spiritual stroll around centuries-old stupas and monasteries. South of Nepal's mountains lies something completely different: a chain of wild and woolly national parks, where nature buffs scan the subtropical treetops for exotic bird species and comb the jungles for rhinos, tigers and crocodiles.

Day 01- Arrival in Kathmandu

Meet our representative upon arrival in Kathmandu- an exotic and fascinating showcase of a very rich culture, art and tradition. The valley, roughly an oval bowl, is encircled by a range of green terraced hills and dotted by compact clusters of red tiled-roofed houses. After reaching, check-in at the hotel and spend rest of the evening at leisure. Overnight stay in Kathmandu.

Day 02 - Sightseeing in Kathmandu

After breakfast, explore Kathmandu today- visit Pashupatinath temple, Boudhanath temple and Durbar Square. Also visit Swayambhunath Stupa, the most ancient and enigmatic of all the holy shrines in Kathmandu valley. In evening, visit Thamel & Garden of Dreams. Overnight in Kathmandu.

Day 03 - Kathmandu – Pokhara (210 kms / approx.5 hours)

After breakfast, drive to Pokhara and enroute enjoy a cable car ride to Manakamana temple. Pokhara is known for its lovely lakes Phewa, Begnas and Rupa, which have their source in the glacial Annapurna Range of the Himalayas. Today visit Sarangkot, Davi's waterfall, the old Bazaar and Bindyabasini Temple. Later, enjoy boat ride on Phewa Lake. Overnight in Pokhara.

Day 04 - Pokhara – Chitwan (140 kms / approx. 4 hours)

After breakfast, drive to Chitwan- meaning 'Heart of the Jungle', is one of the premier drawcards in Nepal. The World Heritage-listed reserve protects over 932 sq km of forests, marshland and rippling grassland, and is home to sizeable populations of wildlife. On arrival relax at the hotel or optional visit to Tharu Village. Overnight in Chitwan.

Day 05 - Chitwan

Today after breakfast, start with elephant safari, which provides an opportunity to get a close view of the endangered one-horned rhinoceros. You may also get a glimpse of the elusive Bengal tiger. Later, hop into a wooden canoe for a tour of the Rapti River, where the Gharial crocodiles sunbathe on the shores. Rest of the day will be free for leisure or enjoying jungle activities such as nature walk. Overnight in Chitwan.

Day 06 - Chitwan – Nagarkot (120 kms / approx. 3.5 hours)

After breakfast, drive to Nagarkot – famous for viewing sunrise, sunset and a magnificent view of the Langtang range. Green hills, clean and fresh environment and the unobstructed views of Langtang range are the main features of Nagarkot. One can experience a majestic view of a whole range of mountains from Nagarkot extending from Mt Dhaulagir in the west to Mt Everest in the East. Spend evening at leisure. Overnight stay in Nagarkot.

Day 07 - Nagarkot – Kathmandu (35 kms / approx 1 hour) | Departure from Kathmandu

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Kathmandu airport for return flight back home.
